

### OUR VENUE

Designed by Six Degrees, Cassette is a light-filled, welcoming space for all to kick back in and unwind.

Once the home of tape gurus Dex Audio, the space now houses a cosy cafe and community gathering space with friendly faces to greet and serve you.

Accented by Australian spotted gum, terrazzo and raw metals, the form and feel of Cassette harks back to the indsutrial roots of Kensington, Melbourne.

From small intimate dinners to networking mixers, there are sev-eral flexible spaces and setups available at Cassette for hosting any celebration in mind.









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Sitting at the heart of Cassette, our main dining room is wrapped around with tall windows, indoor planting and furnished warmly with timber and forest green seating.

The ideal spot for any occasion - comfortably seating 28 patrons or standing room for 40 patrons.

When booked with adjoining Macaulay Room, groups of 40 seated or 60 standing patrons can be accommodated for.

## COMMUNAL TABLE

The Communal Table is a casual space for more informal soirees and mingling, best experienced on one of our grazing table offerings.

With great looks into the hustle and bustle of the open kitchen and bar, up to 25 patrons both seated and standing can socialise and soak in this Cassette space.





### MACAULAY ROOM



Nestled behind the Main Dining room, the Macaulay Room is a private, sunlit pocket of Cassette with versatility.

This space can accomodate 18 seated guests for an intimate dinner and has AV capabilities and privacy curtains for more corporate affairs.

## TERMS+ CONDITIONS

### 01. MENU OFFERING

The menu offerings stated are sample menus only and changes frequently depending on seasonal availabilities and what's coming into our kitchen from our farmers and suppliers each week.

### **02. DIETARY REQUIREMENTS**

Dietaries and allergens can be accommodated. We require these to be confirmed two weeks prior to your reservation.

### 03. RESERVATIONS

Reservations are not confrimed until a 50% deposit is received which will be required at the time of booking in your reservation. Any cancellations made two weeks outside of your reservation will receive their full deposit. Any cancellations within two weeks of the event will be charged a fee of 50% of their deposit. Cancellations within four business days will be charged a fee of 100% of their deposit. Dates changes to your reservation may be accommodated for at the venues discretion.

### 04. LAST CALL

From Monday to Thursday and Sunday, Cassette will need to be vacated by 10 pm due to licensing parameters. On Fridays, Saturdays and public holidays, Cassette will need to be vacated by 11 pm in line with Victorian EPA guidelines.

### **05. SURCHARGES**

Surcharges will be applied and added to your final bill. Saturday and Sundays will incur a 10% surcharge and public holidays will a incur 15% surcharge. Accepted cards are Visa, Mastercard, American Express and cash payments as well. Accepted cards are Visa, Mastercard, American Express and cash payments as well. Please note a 1.5% surcharge will apply to all credit cards. We are only able to issue one bill per event and we cannot split bills under any circumstances.

### **05. EXCLUSIVE VENUE HIRE**

Exclusive venue hire requires a minimum spend which will be calculated depending on the night of the reservation.

### **06. FULLY LICENSED**

Cassette is fully licensed and BYO is not permitted.

### **07. DUTY OF CARE**

Cassette has a duty of care to all patrons and as such reserves the right to refuse the service of alcohol to any person we deem intoxicated or anyone providing alcohol to said intoxicated guest.

### 08. NOTSE LEVELS

Any noise level deemed excessive by Cassette – which may be of a disturbance to customers or surrounding residents - must be ceased immediately upon being informed by a member of staff.

### 09. SECURITY

For larger, exclusive reservations, security may be required for minimum of four hours at the client's cost.

### 10. PROPERTY

Cassette is not liable to you or your guest in respect to any loss or damage (including consequential loss or damage) which may be suffered or inccured or may arise directly or indirectly during your reservation. Guests will be liable for any damage caused to the venue or to the property of Cassette.

## TERMS+ CONDITIONS

### 11. SMOKING

Please note that smoking or vaping is not permitted in the venue and we kindly ask that smoking takes place in designated areas across street from the venue.

### 12. EQUIPMENT

For use of any of Cassette's audio visual equipment including sound system and projector screen must be pre-arranged with the venue. Any external audio visual equipment is your own responsibility and its use for your event must be pre-arranged and confirmed with venue one week prior to your event.

### 13. DECORATIONS

Decorations of your own are subject to discussions with the venue. If permitted, no items are to be screwed, nailed, stapled or adhered to building's surfaces or fixtures.

### 14. FORCE MAJEURE

If circumstances beyond the control of either party (such as natural disasters, pandemics, or government regulations) prevent the execution of this event, the parties shall negotiate over resolutions and remedial measures in respect of the impact caused by force majeure.
